



Mr. and Miss LaCage Contestant Rules and Regulations



- For Mr. and Miss LaCage, contestants must be at least 21 years of age by the date of the pageant
 - All backup dancers, dressers, or others in attendance must also be 21 years of age
 - Proof of age is required for all parties at registration (bring a valid, state-issued identification card)
- Contestants will be judged in the following categories
 - Presentation (Up to 10 points per judge)
 - Talent (Up to 30 points per judge)
 - On Stage Question (Up to 25 points per judge)
 - Mr. – Club Wear (Up to 20 points per judge)
 - Miss – Evening Gown (Up to 20 points per judge)
 - Mr. – Formal Wear (Up to 20 points per judge)
- Judging is scored using a total point accumulated scoring system
 - Scoring sheets are provided by LaCage
 - In the event of a tie, the winner is determined by the contestant with the higher score in talent
 - In the event of a tie in talent, the higher score in On Stage Question followed by Formal Wear will decide.
- Talent presentation is limited to a maximum of seven (7) minutes
 - Talents over seven (7) minutes will have administrative points deducted
 - Prop setup and tear down is limited to a maximum of two (2) minutes on each end.
- Any type of talent presentation is acceptable, except those containing the potential to cause injury to the audience or any other person
 - No excessive glitter, fire, water, unwrapped straw (hay), or live animals may be used in any talent
- Music **MUST** be turned in on CD
 - Your talent music and crowning music **MUST** be on separate CD's
 - Your talent music must be on your first CD and labeled with: Your Name – CD# 1 Talent
 - Your crowning music must be on a second CD labeled with: Your Name – CD# 2 Crowning
 - **DO NOT** use commercial CD's or have any other music or tracks on these CD's
- Any contestant **NOT** in the appointed place at the appointed time loses administrative points
- The use of or dispensing of any illegal drugs will not be tolerated while a contestant is participating in the Mr. and Miss LaCage pageant
 - Immediate disqualification results from those breaking this rule with no refund of entry fee(s)
- Any contestant, contestant's dancer, dresser, etc who is caught stealing or tampering with another person's possessions or an altercation with other dressers or contestants is immediately disqualified and removed from the location of the contest with no refund of entry fees
- Contestants must reside in the state of Wisconsin and must not have any pending or outstanding arrest warrants



Mr. and Miss LaCage Contestant Rules and Regulations



- The winner of Mr. or Miss LaCage is required to compete at state (Mr. Wisconsin Club or Miss Club Wisconsin)
 - Mr. LaCage MUST compete at Mr. Wisconsin Club
 - Miss LaCage MUST compete at Miss Club Wisconsin
 - The entry fee for either contest (Mr. or Miss Club) for the winner is paid by LaCage
 - Any winner of Mr. and Miss LaCage whom does not enter and compete in the appropriate Club contest forfeit their step down money

- The winner of Mr. or Miss LaCage agrees to NOT compete for another comparable bar title for the duration of their reign
 - If the winner of Mr. or Miss LaCage competes for another comparable bar title, they revoke their title
 - In addition, the individual also forfeits their step down money, loses their remaining bookings at LaCage, and must return the crown
 - Failure to comply with the above will result in a permanent ban in performing at LaCage

- All parties a contestant brings to Mr. and Miss LaCage to assist with their efforts, must pay an entry fee
 - This includes backup dancers, prop personnel, or any others assisting with the competition
 - Each contestant is allowed one dresser and the entry fee is waived for this person only
 - The entry fee for these individuals is a special rate and lower than the general admission fee
 - Entry fee for these individuals is \$ 4 per person and is payable at registration
 - Each individual must be present and signed in at registration

- The winner of Mr. and Miss LaCage are required to sign a contract with LaCage before any prize money is paid
 - Failure to sign the contract forfeits the title

- Within seven (7) days of winning the contest, the winner of Mr. and Miss LaCage must have, maintain, and provide to the promoters an email address and cell phone number
 - Must remain active for the winner's entire reign
 - Any changes to email address and cell phone number must be communicated immediately with the promoters

- The owners of LaCage reserve the right to make decisions concerning matters not covered by these rules and regulations
